I trust you had a wonderful Thanksgiving. I am so thankful for each of you being part of our Evangelism Mission team of prayer warriors and supporters. God has been so good to propel this mission work across the USA for nearly 16 years now. The Lord willing, this December will be our 16th anniversary. We have evangelized in all 48 contiguous United States sharing the Gospel with hundreds of thousands souls across this land. Because you have prayed and supported you have worked with God to make this happen. You had a part in the multitudes who received the Gospel & the many who found Christ through the years.

What will it take to reach more souls for the Kingdom of God and teach more Christians to be soul winners?

First, it will take God moving on all of us who work for and volunteer with Evangelism Mission. So, we ask you to please put us on your daily prayer list. There are many battles against the enemy throughout each year and only through God moving on us with protection, wisdom and health can we continue in the battle against evil for souls.

Secondly it takes workers. We need help! We need full time workers and volunteers. There are many openings in our mission work from street ministry to church planting and short term teams for tent meetings and street meetings. Thirdly, it takes funds to pay for all the expense of running the mission work; from missionary support and travel expenses, to general operating funds, and the many projects that arise. As you all know the past two years have been crazy. First Covid-19 and now inflation. In times like these mission expenses increase, but sadly because many are hurting financially giving is harder for some now than before. In times like these, our mission works across the world need even more funds to help the hurting and reach the lost. Please prayerfully consider supporting us during our annual End of Year Fund Drive.

Our annual fund drive goals this year are:

- Office Building Project started last November. Praise God you have raise \$13,575 to date. With all the material cost and unexpected expenses of phase one (already complete) it has cost \$17,104.17. We are trying to raise the remaining \$3,529.12 of phase one building expenses including paying off our interest free purchases in Jan. We also need to raise \$2200 for concrete to start phase two of our building project (the restroom and storage area). Our Office Building Project Goal is \$5,529.
- General Fund, the thing rarely supported by name, yet without it we would not have a functioning office. Our General Fund goal to finish out 2022 is \$3,004.
- My missionary fund is for reimbursements



of many out of pocket travel expenses, salary, housing allowance, and medical expenses. This year I've had a series of health problems in addition to all my normal missionary evangelist work, and we started the renovations to the upstairs of the house (funded through my housing allowance). It will be so nice to have a place to live besides the motorhome when not on the road. It has gone very slow because of some health problems and I am careful to pay for labor every week and buying all the materials as I can afford or on interest free promotional purchases. Our goal to reimburse all ministry expenses and meet my remaining board approved annual support throughout the rest of the year is \$18,285.

4. Our Holiness Pioneers goal of \$10,000 is for our mission/church planting efforts. We are still working in Salt Lake City, UT (SLC), starting evangelistic efforts in Providence, RI, and also possibly Connecticut this coming year. The Lord willing, we are trying to raise funds to spend many weeks up to a couple months in SLC to minister to our church people and continue evangelistic outreaches in the new year. We also need to raise funds for tent meeting and outdoor church equipment (several very large popup canopies, seating and a better portable sound system) to begin evangelistic outreaches in RI and CT. The Lord willing we will begin tent meetings and possible church services this year.

As you can see there are many needs in order to reach the areas of the USA that God is leading us to. Your prayers and support will make the differences! Together as we follow God's leading, your prayers and support will help us reach more souls across the USA!
