Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope this letter finds you blessed in the presence of the Lord. Thank you for your kind offerings and your many prayers. God has used them to propel us across the nation once again. Below I will share a brief update, praises, and prayer requests.

This trip has been hindered by four occurrences of vehicle problems. The first one occurred when the motorhome transmission pan seal started leaking because the pan was bent between bolt holes, resulting in the ne-

cessity of replacing the pan. This caused in myself and other volunteers to lose a day of ministry in Indianapolis. Then the battery had to be replaced in my car. The next problem was a tire blow out on the motorhome. Finally, the pads on the motorhome front brakes had to be replaced unexpectedly since they were just replace 14 months ago. WE NEED PRAYER.



On a more positive note, we were able to visit the ICHA Home Missions Church in Marshfield, Missouri. We had a successful visit and analyzed the community for a fu-

ture outreach event. We also made it to Phoenix and were able to do an outreach in the downtown area with people from The Gospel Center and brother McBride with the Wesleyan Holiness Association of Churches. We were also able to strategize with the Phoenix Wesleyan Holiness Church to plan out a fu-



ture outreach and helped them design a sign for their property. We were able to make it to Kingman, AZ for outreach and a church service in the park. Sadly our church service in the park was poorly attended because it was hindered by cold weather and high winds causing.

- Safety when the tire blew out.
- Free mechanics to resolve the leaking transmission pan issue at two different garages. We paid for parts only!
